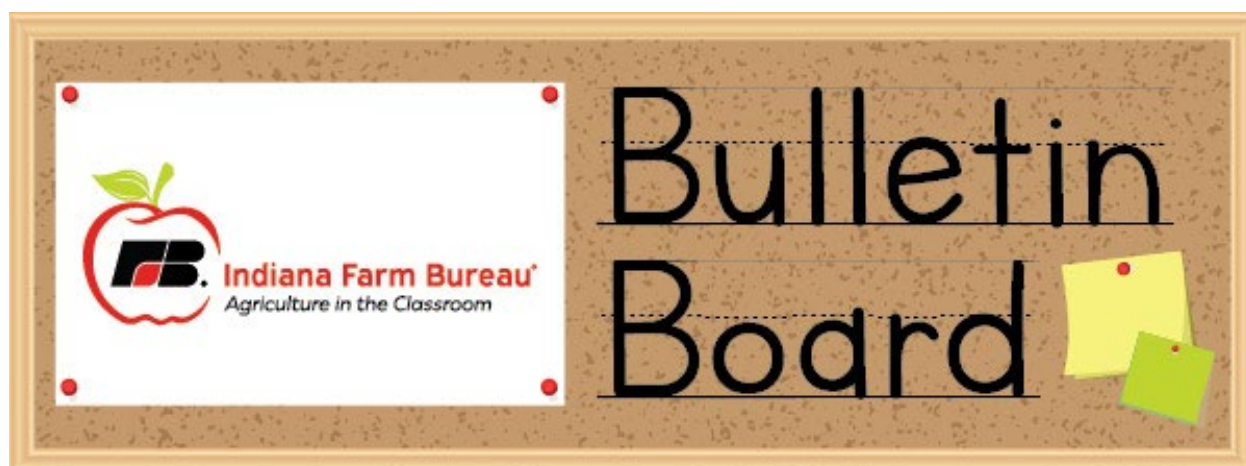




2025 Summer Ag in the Classroom Workshops

White-Reinhardt Grants

The [White-Reinhardt Grant Program](#) funds projects that will increase agricultural literacy. County and state Farm Bureaus may apply for \$1,000 grants for education programs for grades K-12 to initiate new ag literacy programs or expand existing ones. Organizations and individual schools can work with their local Farm Bureaus to apply. Applications are due June 13, 2025.
