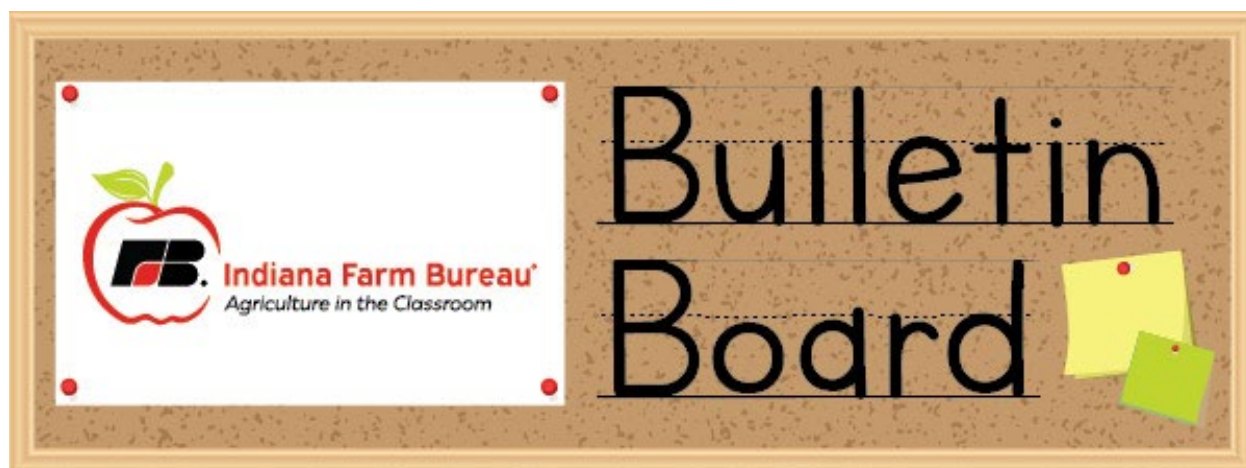




Indiana Activity Sheets
