

Jeff Cummins Director of State Government Affairs, Environment & Natural Resources

Jeff Cummins joined Indiana Farm Bureau in December 2019 as a member of the public policy team. He currently serves as the director of state government affairs, environment and natural resources for Indiana Farm Bureau and handles many of INFB's policy and regulatory priorities with a focus on environmental and natural resource issues.

The environmental issues range from Waters of the U.S. (WOTUS) at the federal level as well as wetlands, pesticide and carbon sequestration issues at the state level, while natural resource issues range from drainage to regulation of state and local waterways.



Cummins also is active in zoning and land use issues as they affect environmental and energy projects, and he helps manage AgELECT, INFB's political action committee that focuses on candidate endorsements and issues.

Prior to joining INFB, Cummins was with the Indiana State Department of Agriculture for nearly five years, serving in various roles on the policy team but most recently as general counsel and legislative director. He also spent two years at the Office of the Indiana Attorney General.

Cummins is from Austin, Indiana, and earned his undergraduate and law degrees from Indiana University.
