Kenneth Smith, P.E., recently retired as an Assistant Director of the Indiana DNR's Division of Water, where he led the Projects and Compliance Branch (which included the Dam and Levee Safety Section). He is a past-President of the Association of State Dam Safety Officials (ASDSO) and a Registered Professional Engineer in Indiana, with 48 years of experience, in civil / water resource engineering, design, project and construction management, dam and levee safety, floodplain management, permitting, compliance, legislative and litigation support, and public outreach.
