Purpose statement	The purpose statement is clear.	10

Goals	Three or more goals are well-	5
	defined using a SMART model	
	(specific, measurable,	
	attainable, realistic and time).	
	Three goals are vaguely	3
	identified and SMART elements	
	are missing.	
	Less than three goals are	1
	identified and components of	
	SMART goals are missing.	
Program Description	The program is described in	10
	detail including but not limited	
	to:	
	 Who will plan the 	
	program?	
	 Who will attend the 	
	program?	
	 Where will the program 	
	take place?	
	 How long will the 	
	program last?	
	 What will participants 	
	experience at the	
	program?	
	The program is adequately	5
	described but one or two details	
	are missing.	

	The program is poorly described, and more than two	1
	details are missing.	
Innovation and Growth	The proposed program is new	15
	and innovative (or recurring	
	with new elements) and will	
	provide growth opportunities	
	for the FFA or 4-H members.	
	The proposed program lacks	7
	innovation, but will still provide	
	growth opportunities for FFA or	
	4-H members.	
	The proposed program is a	1
	recurring event with no new	
	elements added for growth	
	opportunities for FFA or 4-H	
	members.	
Budget Outline	The budget clearly defines how	10
	the grant money will be used	
	and indicates good stewardship	
	of grant funds.	
	The budget is adequately	5
	described and indicates some	
	stewardship of the grant funds.	
	The budget lacks description	1
	and does not indicate good	
	stewardship of the grant funds.	
Spelling and Grammar	Application is free of any	5
	spelling or grammatical errors.	
	Spelling and/or grammatical	3
	errors were noted but did not	
	distract from the content of the	
	application.	
	Numerous spelling and/or	1
	grammatical errors were noted	
	and distracted from the content	
	of the application.
