## **Outstanding County Program**

### PURPOSE

The Outstanding County Young Farmers & Ag Professionals Program is designed to recognize and award those counties in Indiana with active county programs.

## AWARDS

Plaques will be awarded to the **top three** county Young Farmers & Ag Professionals programs. Of the top three counties, the representative and guest of the **highest scoring** county program will be awarded a trip to the American Farm Bureau Federation (AFBF) Young Farmer & Rancher Leadership Conference in 2020.

The **Most Improved** designation will be awarded to the one county that has the greatest increase in score, based upon the comparison of the previous two application forms. The county that receives this designation will receive a plaque recognizing that county as the most improved.

Up to three counties can be recognized with a certificate for the **Awakening Award**. The Awakening Award was started in 1998 to recognize County Young Farmers & Ag Professionals Programs that are new or have not applied for the contest in the last three years. The three counties that have the highest scores and have not applied in the past three years would be eligible for this award and receive a certificate recognizing their achievements.

Recognition will take place during the Indiana Farm Bureau Young Farmers & Ag Professionals Leadership Conference, held annually at the end of January in Indianapolis. Winning counties may be asked to share their county's activities during the conference.

## ELIGIBILITY

All Indiana Farm Bureau County Young Farmers & Ag Professionals programs are eligible to apply. The program dates are October 1 to September 30. *\*The same representative of a county cannot attend the YF&R Conference two consecutive years.* 

#### JUDGING

The point system to be used is as stated on the application form. If there is a tie, the tiebreaker will be the county with the most people attending the previous year's Young Farmer Leadership Conference, followed by the combined participation in the Achievement Award, Excellence in Ag Award and the Discussion Meet.
